Input: Look at some letter examples and remind yourself of the features of a letter. Then think carefully about the jobs you have in the classroom. Eg line leader, water bottle monitor, cloakroom monitor. Which job is your favourite? Why should you be picked to carryout that job and how much money do you think you should be paid for it? Task: Write a bullet point list of reasons why you should have that job. eg I'm very reliable. I know how to line up smartly. I always help others.	Input: Discuss the features of a letter and look at some examples of good letters. What makes them good? Remind yourself of the job you chose yesterday and your reasons why you should be given the job. Task: Write a letter to your teacher to persuade them to give you the job. Remember to include all the reasons why and how much you think you should be paid! Read it back. Does it make sense?	Input: Use books and the internet to find out about your dream job. What is involved in your dream job? What qualifications do you need? Etc. Task: Write a short paragraph about your chosen job to explain to someone else what the job involves. You might include answers to some of the following questions: - What qualities and skills do you need? - Where would you work? - Do you need a uniform? - How much money do you get paid? - What is the best thing about the job?
