Read through your story and check it makes sense. Then see if you have the correct punctuation, adjectives, conjunctions, expanded noun phrases, adverbs, and prepositions.	Your teacher will send you a copy of your exciting writing that you completed last week.
In today's session we are going to look at the structure of a story and then plan our own.	You need to write more detailed sentences to describe what is going to happen in each part of the story.	Think about what you need to include: Capital letters and full stops Adjectives Expanded noun phrases Conjunctions Adverbs Prepositions	Once you have edited your story, can you ask someone at home to read through it and give you two stars and a wish?	Edit your work and complete each editing station.
Using the story planner sheet, plan your story. This needs to be notes, not full sentences.	You need to write at least one more sentence to each section of your story planner, including an adjective, descriptive phrases, an expanded noun phrase and adverbs.
