Can you explain why you think this? Can you use the images or name of the book?</p> <p><b>Task two:</b> Now look at the back of the book and the blurb. Does this tell you anything extra? Has your prediction</p>	<p>In today's session we are going to be describing a character within the book. We are going to be doing this purely with an image, we aren't going to read the book yet.</p> <p><b>Task one:</b> Choose one of the characters from the PowerPoint and complete the role in the wall. On the inside write the feelings/emotion you think the character is feeling from the image. Then on the outside write words and phrases about the characters appearance.</p> <p><b>Task two:</b> Can you write some sentences to describe your character.</p>	<p>In today's session we are going to be looking at action verbs.</p> <p>Work through the PowerPoint.</p> <p><b>Task one:</b> Look at the pieces of text, can you highlight the action verbs that you can find.</p> <p><b>Task two:</b> Write your own sentences including action verbs. Challenge- can you include adjectives and conjunctions?</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> Complete the worksheet.
