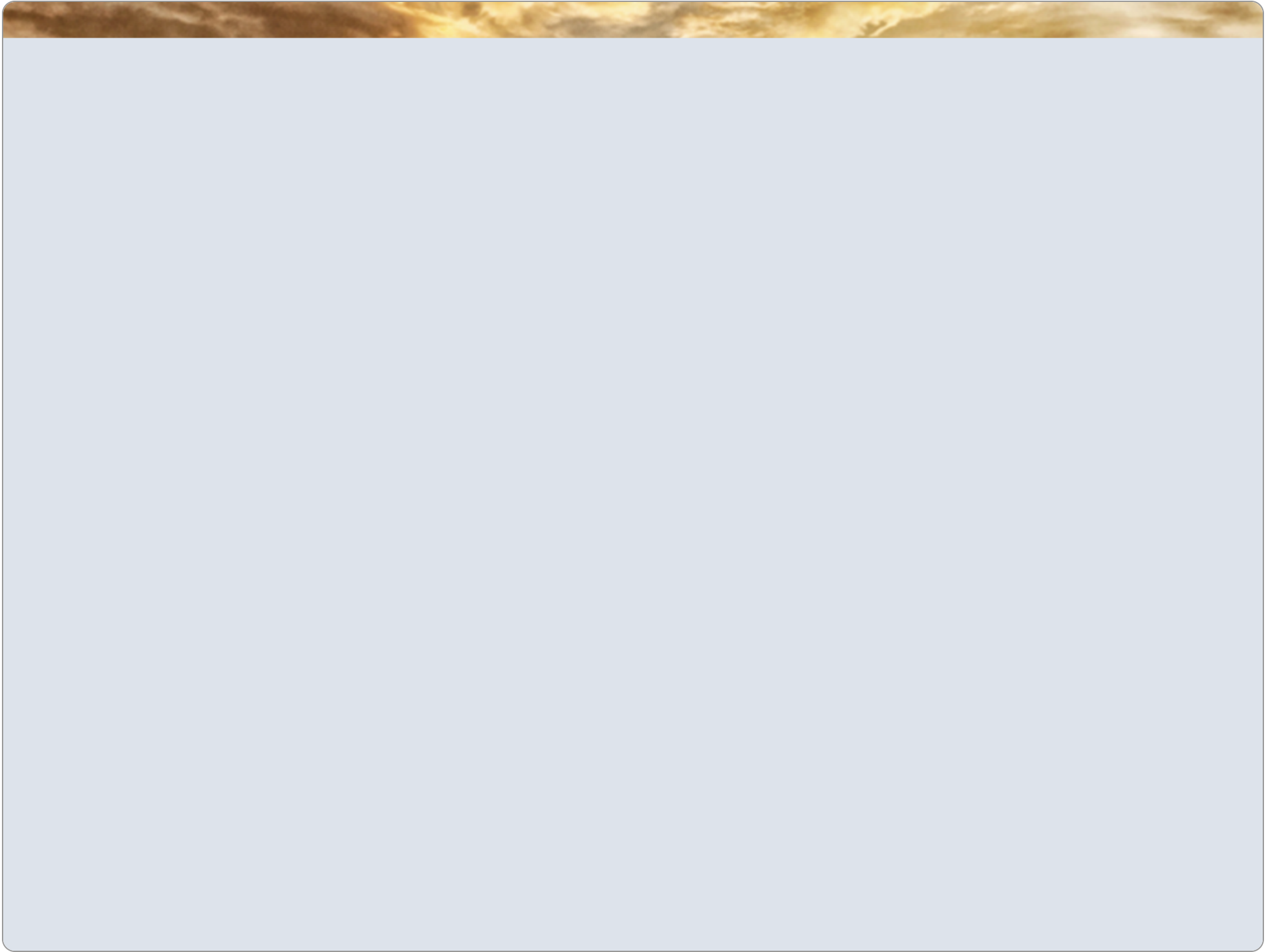




Flying

- Flying over the bear during the flight wasn't a good idea.

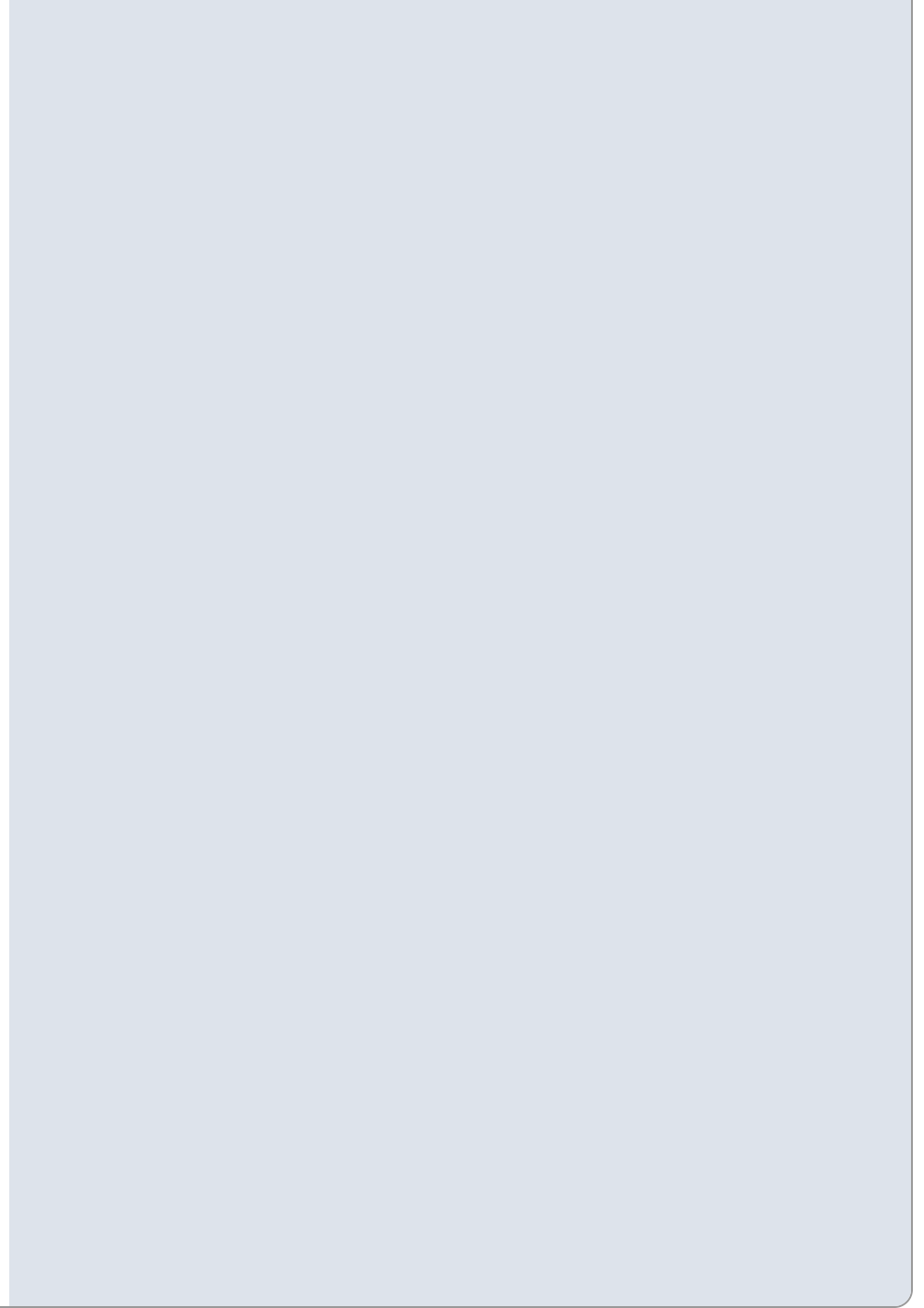
