Activity 2: Your task is to begin the first two sections of your report. 1st section: This should include details of evidence found at the scene, and answer the questions who, what, where and when. 2nd section: Contains witness statements from interviews, written in reported speech. Use the information from your interviews conducted last week. Challenge: Begin to plan your final section, in which the investigator explains what they think happened, based on the evidence.	Spag starter- follow link to complete the Pobble activity on formal writing. Follow the lesson presentation and answer the questions given. Activity 1: Read through the example report one more time. How formal is the writing? Who is the report written for? Have they used speech marks? Why? Finally, examine how the writer has used description of the facts- the writing is factual.
