You will need to persuade Zoe you are on her side! Activity 1: To write a letter to Zoe, giving her advice on whether or not she should trust Dooby. 1. Make sure you talk directly to Zoe and let her know you are on her side. 2. Challenge yourself to use modal verbs in your writing. 3. Ensure you explain clearly what you think she should do. Challenge: Carefully order your ideas so you come to a strong conclusion.	Spag Focus: To learn how to use the relative clause to add more information about a noun.
