Before you begin, examine the Non-Chron report knowledge organiser to make sure you understand the features of this text type. Task 1: To write the main body of your report, in separate paragraphs each of which begins with a sub-heading. Ensure you are fully explaining your ideas- how could you improve the writing of the notes on slide 4? Task 2: Read through all of your completed paragraphs and write a short introductory paragraph to get your reader's interest and explain what your report's overall subject is. Plenary: Use the self-assessment checklist to assess your writing. Look for evidence of each point in your writing before you tick it. Y6 Challenge: Write using passive voice and relative clause in your work.	In this lesson you will be editing your writing to create a final draft. Task 1: Complete your report with a short concluding paragraph. This should aim to sum up the main ideas of your report, and to explain how the events you described affect us in the modern day. Task 2: Read carefully through your whole report, editing for spelling, capital letters and punctuation. Then check for descriptive phrases and connectives. Finally, edit for word choices and tense. (in a historical report, usually past tense but may switch to present tense in conclusion). Task 3. Put it all together in your 'published draft'. Think about how you will present your work to make it visually interesting to the reader. Ensure you have included all of the corrections and edits you made previously.
