<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> <p>Talk about what makes a good friend. What do your friends do that make you feel good? How can you be a good friend? What can you do if someone is feeling upset?</p> 	<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>Encourage your child to listen carefully by playing a game of 'Simon says'. If your child struggles to listen to instructions, call their name first. Eg "Sally, Simon says jump up and down."</p> 	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Joe Wicks – Virtual PE teacher delivering 30 minute PE lessons Monday – Friday 9:00am</p> <p>Chat-Talk with your child about exercise, its effect on their bodies and the positive contribution it can make to their health. What happens to your body when you exercise?</p>

Eg 1 doll, 2 socks, 3 forks, 4 chairs, 5 fingers, 6 pencils etc. Can you get up to 20?</p>	<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Our new topic this term is Awesome Africa. Look on Espresso to find out some facts about Africa. Can you find Africa on a map of the world? What is the weather like? What kind of animals live in Africa?</p>
