<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> <p>Draw a detailed picture of yourself and colour it in. All around it write down things you are good at. Think about the things that make you special. Do you have any talents? What do you enjoy doing?</p> 	<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>Capture moments of your child role playing in the role play area you have created. Add a couple of short video clips of them playing to Tapestry.</p> 	<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Joe Wicks – Virtual PE teacher delivering 30 minute PE lessons Monday – Friday 9:00am</p> <p>Fine motor- stand some spaghetti upright in some playdough and thread cheerios onto it. How many can you slide on in 1 minute? Who can make the tallest tower of cheerios in 1 minute? Or thread penne pasta onto spaghetti or string. You could make a necklace!</p> 
<p>Literacy- Reading</p> <p>Dig out the dressing-up clothes, or borrow some from a grown up and search for some props- get creative and recreate your favourite book cover by creating a freeze frame. Can you see any blossom on the trees? Can you see any flowers growing? Can you see the trees are turning green? Can you see or hear any birds tweeting?</p>
<p>Literacy-Writing</p> <p>Can you think of and write one word for each letter of the alphabet? Use your phonics knowledge to carefully sound out the words and write them down, remembering to keep your writing neat and letters sitting on the line correctly.</p> 	<p>Maths- Shape, Space and Measure</p> <p>Online: Choose a sorting activity from the Espresso problem solving activity area. https://central.espresso.co.uk/espresso/modules/ey_problem_solving/activities/index.html</p>	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>Dance around the room to your favourite song. Can you make up some new dance moves? Put on a show for the other members of your family.</p>
