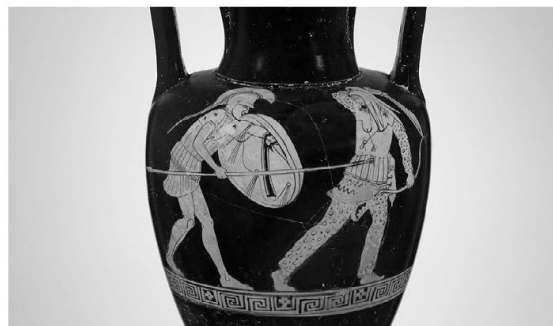




Topic: History



TASK ONE:

Designs on Ancient Greek pottery tell us lots about what life was like in Ancient Greece. Some vases or pots have images showing us daily life, some show battle scenes and some show scenes from myths (sometimes including images of the Greek gods).

Design your own Greek pot, using the template provided by school. Write a brief paragraph explaining your pot and imagery chosen. What can someone learn about Ancient Greece from looking at your design?

Some ideas for designs: daily life for women, men or children; sporting events; battles; the Trojan War; Greek myths; or your own idea.

TASK TWO:

Legacies: things that have lived on after someone has died or a civilisation or event has ended.

Research a legacy of the Ancient Greek civilisation and record your findings.

Learning



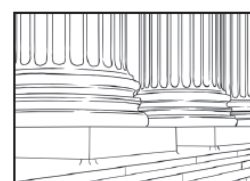
Ever since ancient Greek times, philosophers, scientists and mathematicians have influenced the way that people think and understand the world. You could explore one or more examples.
