Your homework for this week is to visit an ecosystem

This might be a lake, pond, woodland or even a hedgerow. The undersides of rocks and logs often accommodate their own mini ecosystems, with living things specially adapted to life there.

Look at the living things around you in your chosen ecosystem, and sketch the plants and animals that you see. Label any features of the organisms that show how it is adapted to its environment.

Make observations about the temperature, levels of sunlight and moisture, and the availability and source of nutrients and food within the ecosystem.
