Your task is to research a member of your family who lived during
World War 2.

This could be somebody such as a grandparent or great-grandparent, or great
aunts or uncles.

You could interview the older members of your family, and ask if they could
share any memories or tell you any stories about your chosen person.

- How is this person related to you?
- Can you find any evidence about their life, such as letters or photographs?
- When were they born?
- Where did they live?
- What did they do during the war?
- Were they part of the military, or a civilian?



Example

George Pattinson (1921-1996)

Relationship to Mr Greenham: Grandfather.

George was a young carpenter when the war broke out, he went to work in the shipyards building wooden parts for ships and submarines.

After the war, he re-trained as a nurse and worked in hospitals near his home town of Barrow-in-Furness.

If you cannot find a relative that was involved in WW2,
you can pick one of these famous people and research
them.

Tasker Watkins, recipient of the Victoria Cross
Eric Stanley Lock, most kills in the Battle of Britain
Patrick Devine, evacuated to Clydach in South Wales
Vera Lynn, famous wartime singer
