



Homework for this half term (due in Friday 9th February)

Your homework for this half term is to create a fluency Maths



game for other children to play. For Reception children, the content should be number bonds that pair together to make 10, 20, 50 or 100 (parents will need to guide depending on the development of your particular child). For Key Stage 1 children, the game should be based around the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and for Key Stage 2, your game should be based around all of the times tables up to 12 x 12.

Remember, the aim is that all children should know all of their tables by the end of Year 4.

You may present your game however you choose. It could be a board game, a coded computer game, a loop card game, pairs, a poster with lift-up flaps or something even more creative. Those children in Key Stage 2 should aim to spend about between 3 and 4 hours during the half term on this work. For the younger children, this is optional and time spent should be at parents' discretion.

Most importantly, have fun and be ready to share your game with your class at the end of term!
