Roll up roll up! Great Staughton Primary Academy will be hosting a one of a kind exhibition of historical artefacts on Friday the 10th of February.

Children in KS2 are invited to prepare an artefact, model, diorama, display poster, video or picture presentation on a historical topic of their choosing.

What should I research?

You could investigate almost any historical topic or question that you think is interesting, such as...

Art history, Boudicca, Castle defences, Egyptians, Fashion, Gladiators, Hadrian's Wall, the Industrial Revolution, Justice, Kings and Queens, Local history...

To get you started, here are a few suggestions:

Why did Oliver Cromwell want to get rid of Christmas?

Did ladies' corsets really make them faint?

Why did the Titanic sink?



Remember, as we want all of the children to have time to explore the exhibition, you will not be able to stay with your work to explain it. This means your work needs to be able to speak for itself! You might wish to prepare an artefact label or handout to tell people about your work.
