Part 2: Culture.

Your task is to learn more about the culture of your country. There are lots of ways you might do this:

- Read a story or watch a children's film from your country and write a review.
- Learn a song or a game to teach to the class.
- Try cooking a famous dish from this country and take pictures.
- Learn about an artist from your country, respond to their work or make your own composition in their style.
- Design an outfit inspired by the national costume.
- Write a report on interesting festivals or traditions celebrated in your country.
