

Teacher notes and instructions

Instructions:

- 1) Shuffle the money cards. Place them face down on the table.
- 2) Player 1 will pick a card and write down the amount shown in the table. Player 2 will then do the same.
- 3) Compare the numbers using the signs > or < (or alternatively, greater than and less than).
- 4) Record the winner of each round.

The winner is the player with the most greater than signs in the table.
