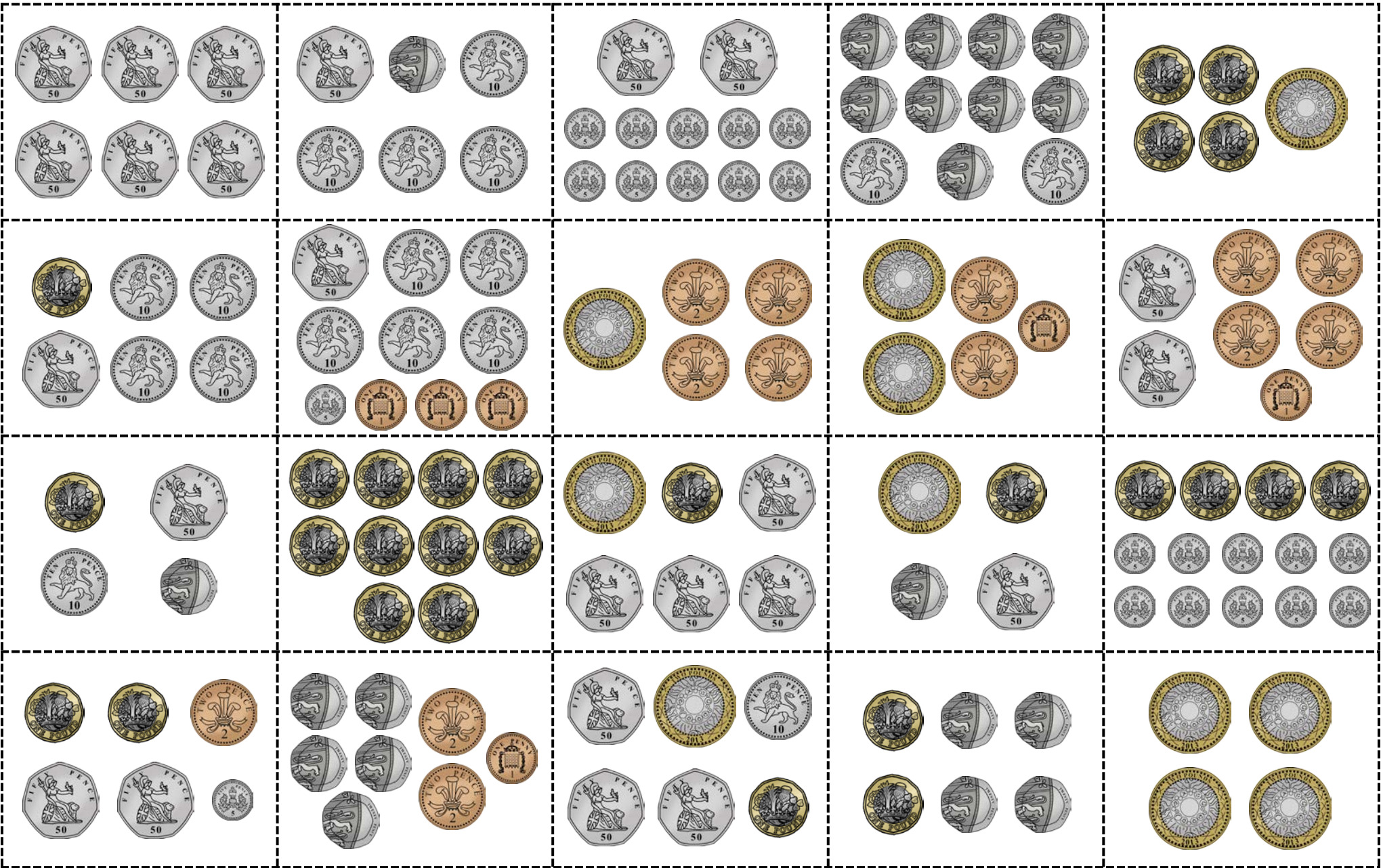

Money cards - coins



Teacher notes and instructions

Instructions:

- 1) Shuffle the money cards. Place them face down on the table.
 - 2) Player 1 will pick a card and write down the amount shown in the table. Player 2 will then do the same.
 - 3) Compare the numbers using the signs $>$ or $<$ (or alternatively, greater than and less than).
 - 4) Record the winner of each round.
- The winner is the player with the most greater than signs in the table.

Example:

Player 1: <u>Rob</u>	> or <	Player 2: <u>Abbie</u>	Winner
100p	<	£1 and 10p	<u>Abbie</u>

Developing



Children will play using the written amounts.
They will use the game board requiring the use of terminology ‘greater than’ and ‘less than’.

Secure



Children will play using the written amount and the coin cards.
They will use the game board requiring the use of inequality signs.

Mastery



Children will play using only the coin cards requiring them to calculate each amount shown.
They will use the game board requiring the use of inequality signs.
