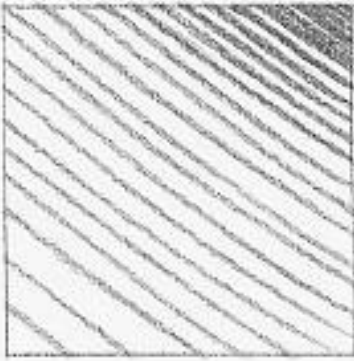

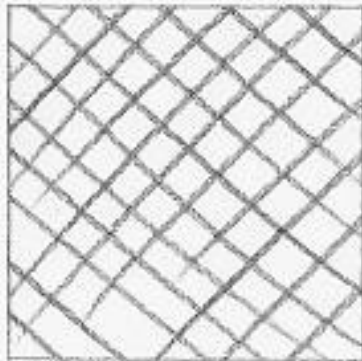

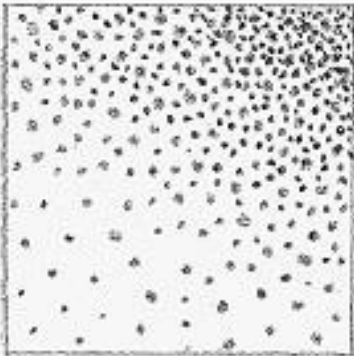




Hatching

Different shading techniques

When you are drawing I want to see if you can try different shading.

On your piece of paper try the different shading.

Your task:

Choose a natural object to make a drawing of. Look at your object carefully.

1. What shape is it? Feel the shape of your object with your fingers. Draw this shape on your paper to make the outline.
2. Look closely at the surface of your object. Find all the little lines, bumps, wrinkles, spikes and curves. Put these in your drawing too.
3. When you think you have finished, look at your object through the magnifying glass. Can you see anything you have missed?
