Could: Can relate to a personal experience.

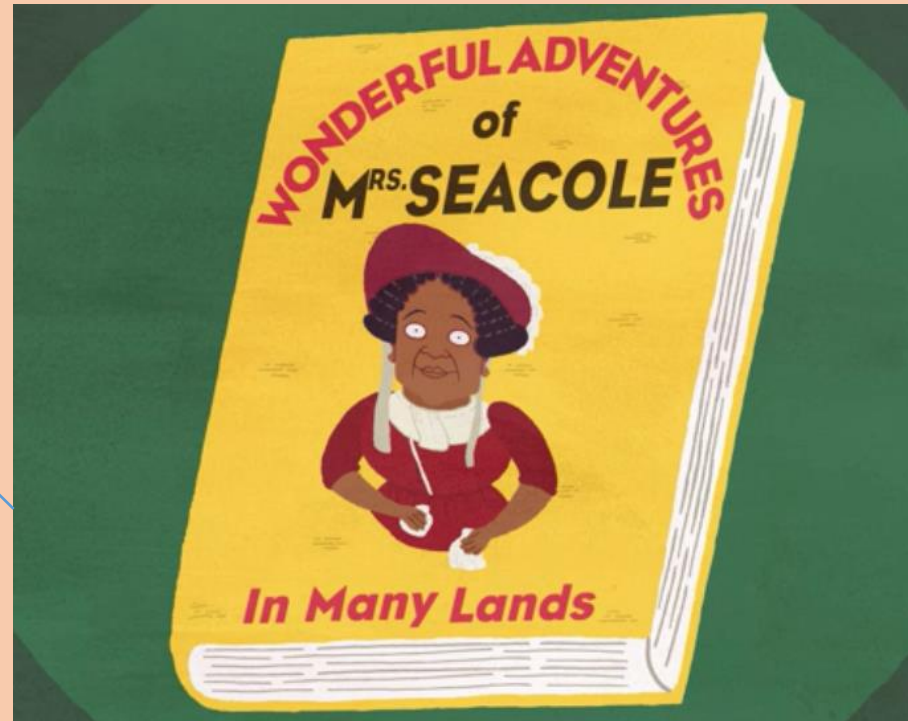
Year 1 LO: To compare the role of nurses in different historical periods.
