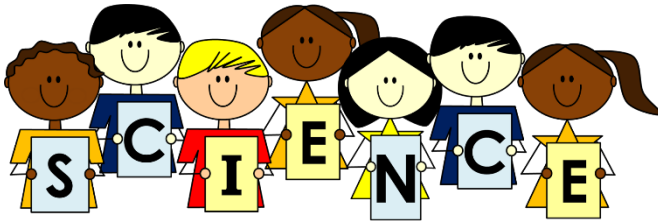
SAWG Days (Monday and Tuesday) - Science focus

SAWG Days (Monday and Tuesday) - Geography focus

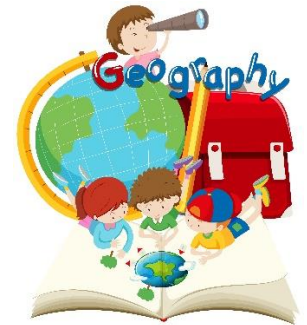
Think about the village/town that you live in. Has it always been the same over the years? How has it developed over the last 10 years? 50 years? 100 years?

Go through PowerPoint and select tasks to complete.

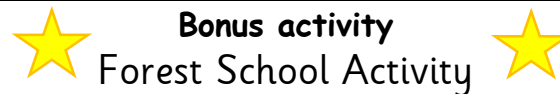


PSHE (Friday)
