

Year 4 Home Learning for Week Commencing 7th March 2022



Science

LO: To make careful observations over time.

In this lesson you will be completing the test you planned last session.

Task 1: This test will take at least several days. We will be observing how different liquids affect the shells of hard-boiled eggs. The eggs should be placed in containers of your chosen liquids and observed closely once per day for 5 days.

Task 2: Use the 'Tooth decay recording' activity sheet to record your observations.

Plenary: Once you have completed your observations, write a conclusion to explain what your test has taught you.

Extension activity- Think of a new test based on what you have learned from the previous test.

Topic

LO: To learn about key turning points of WW2.

In this lesson we will be learning about the key events of world war 2 up until the surrender of Japan in 1945.

Task 1: Sort the WW2 events cards into chronological order. Have you heard of some of these events before? Are there any which are new to you? If you have any questions, you could add these to your KWL grid.

Task 2: As there is so much to know about WW2, we will be researching different areas of the conflict and presenting what we have learned. You can choose to research one of the following events.

- The Dunkirk evacuation.
- The German invasion of Russia.
- The Bombing of Pearl Harbour.
- The Dam busters raid.
- The Normandy landings.

You can choose how to present what you have learned- this could be a PowerPoint presentation, a double page spread or a fact file.
