Topic

Science

LO: To identify electrical appliances and the types of electricity they use

Activity 1:

What is an appliance? An Appliance is a device, piece of equipment or an instrument designed to perform a task. Sort the appliance cards into two groups: those that use electricity and those that do not. Check your work against the answer sheet.

Activity 2:

There are two types of electricity: mains electricity (where an appliance is plugged into a socket) and battery electricity. Take another look at your electrical appliance cards; complete a Venn diagram to sort them into mains and battery powered appliances.

Activity 3:

Research renewable energy sources, including their benefits and drawbacks.

Experiment creating the effect of fire using different mediums. This might be using pencil tones for shading, colouring pencils, crayons, pastels, paints or even computer software.
