Science (Monday)

LO: To construct a simple food web and represent the feeding relationships within a familiar habitat

Watch the BBC video to recap our learning about food chains and to find out about food webs: [food chains and food webs](#)

Look at the completed African food web on the resources page. What do you notice about the relationships between the different animals? Can you identify the different predators and prey?

Use the information text sheets and images of British woodland wildlife to create a food web. You could use wool or string to show the connections between the organisms. Use your completed food web to help you answer the following questions about the interdependence of animals:

- What would happen if the producer in the food web died?
- What might happen if a disease killed all the earthworms?
- What could happen if pesticides caused the barn owls' eggs to break?

LO: To complete research based on Shakespeare and the Globe Theatre (English Renaissance)
