Science (Monday)

LO: I can sort and describe materials

LO: I can identify and explain the different states of matter

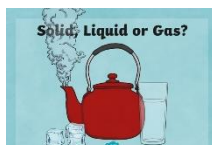
Before you look at the PowerPoint, complete a mind map or make some jottings about what you already know about the states of matter (solid, liquid, gas).

Go through the PowerPoint 'Where does our water come from'.

Answer the questions from the PowerPoint and use the links provided.

Activity:

Create your own poster or PowerPoint sharing scientific information about the states of matter (solid, liquid, gas). Reflect on the particles of each state, their properties and naming familiar items.



Topic (Tuesday)

LO: To locate key rivers of the UK and plot the route of a river

Go through the PowerPoint 'Where does our water come from'.

Answer the questions from the PowerPoint and use the links provided.

Think about the water cycle (science link). This will be covered within your States of Matter work this term. This could link to your KWL grid that is completed at the start of a science block of work.

Activity:

Select the level of difficulty from the 3 level differentiated sheets. Use an atlas or equivalent online resource to complete the task.



Computing (Wednesday)

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Log onto Espresso Coding and complete tasks from 'Block coding'. Continue to work your way through the activities on Level 1 or Level 2 (depending on where you are up to).

Start on Level 3, if you have time.

Complete 30mins - 45mins of work using this program.



Religious Education (Wednesday)

Complete a KWL grid for 'Why do Christians pray and worship?'.

After your initial thoughts, you could look online to find out some information. Keep your research brief at this stage, as this is the introduction session to this block of work.



PE (Friday)

Complete a Joe Wicks' 30 minute workout



Bonus activity

Compare the two videos from 'The Promise' (book used in creative week). One video is the author reading the book and the other is an animated version of the book.

Which one is more enjoyable? Are there any differences? Which one would you remember more information from?

Extension: Play the video on mute. Can you provide a narrative for the story?
