## Science (Monday)

**LO: To show my understanding of sound**

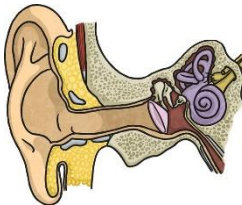
Use the link [Sound and vibration - KS2 Science - BBC Bitesize](#) and watch a few videos (of your choice).

- How are sounds made?
- How do we hear sounds?
- How can we change sounds (e.g. volume or pitch)?
- Why can we not sometimes hear sounds from far away?
- Why do musical instruments make different sounds?

Decide how you would like to present your work.

Extension: Answer your own questions based on sound.

**LO: To write a biography for William Shakespeare**
