Science (Monday)

LO: To identify and describe different stages of the water cycle.

Go through the PowerPoint 'The water cycle' and study the information carefully. You can use other resources such as

Activity 1: Create a diagram of how the water cycle happens. Annotate your diagram with key scientific vocabulary.

Activity 2: Print out and complete an interactive water wheel. Choose the right challenge for you.

Optional Activity: Use the Activity Sheet 'Mini Water World' to create a model of how the water cycle works in action. Observe your mini world over a few days- can you spot evidence of evaporation and condensation?

Topic (Tuesday)

LO: I can explain the impact of damming rivers.

Go through the PowerPoint 'Holding back the Flood'. Use the video links and information in the slides to learn about how dams are used across the world.

Activity 1: Use the resource 'case studies' to research the Aswan Dam in Egypt.

Activity 2: Use the 'Debating Dams' resource to identify the key points for and against the building of the dam. Using this information, write a paragraph to explain your opinion: Was building the dam a good idea?

Optional Task: Hydroelectric energy is a renewable resource created by some dams. Research other renewable sources of energy. Which do you think is the best? Explain why.
