Science

LO: To identify types and functions of teeth.

Follow the lesson presentation and answer the questions given. Use the information to learn about the different kinds of teeth. Use a mirror to compare your teeth to the diagram. Can you identify incisors, canines, premolars and molars? How are they different?

Task 1- Complete the 'types and functions of teeth' activity sheet. Choose the right level for you.

Task 2- Compare how your teeth look as a human to different types of animal teeth. What do you notice? What is different or the same? Can you suggest reasons why they are like this? Complete the 'comparing animals and humans' activity sheet. Choose the right level for you.

Year 4 Challenge- Choose your favourite type of animal, and research how their teeth are different to other animals. What is the reason for this? How do their teeth help them to survive?

Topic

LO: To know what happened during the Blitz.

When did the Blitz begin and end? Why was it named the Blitz? What happened during the Blitz? Where was the Blitz located?
