## Topic (Tuesday)

## LO: To complete research based on Shakespeare and the Globe Theatre

Watch the BBC Bitesize video on Shakespeare and the Globe Theatre in Tudor times -KS2 Historu - BBC Bitesize

Compete research about the Globe Theatre. Some suggestions:

- Who performed on stage?
- What types of plays were performed?
- How much would it cost to watch a play?
- How was the Globe Theatre constructed (e.g. seating plan)?
- How did they achieve special effects?

Activity 2: write a letter to say what a lovely evening you had at the Globe Theatre. Describe the theatre, the play (from English lessons), what you ate/drank etc.
