LO: To investigate materials which will dissolve

Complete the 'Dissolving Investigation' Activity Booklet.

Can you work out the maximum solubility (the point where the material can't be dissolved anymore)? Think about the ratio or liquid to solid to obtain this. *For example, 5 teaspoons of sugar dissolve in 50ml of water. When adding the sixth teaspoon of sugar, residue can be seen at the bottom of the glass.*

Make predictions for your investigation. Were these proved or disproved?
