Topic

LO: To research order of events from the Great Fire of London and the impact this had on London

Activity 1:

Use the internet and/or books to show your understanding of the solar system.

Think about how you would like to present your work. This could be using a PowerPoint, a leaflet, a non-fiction text, posters or a video.

Extension Tasks:

1. Make a hanging model of the solar system (DT link).
2. Design your own planet! Decide which planets it would be between and use what you know to help create the planet. Think about the colours and whether it would be rocky or a gas planet.

LO: To explore the ways in which artists create effects and to experiment with different mediums

Revisit the PowerPoint from last week's art learning. Do the paintings show exactly what the fire was like? What effect do the colours used and textures created have?

Find other pieces of artwork that also show fire. Which is your favourite? Why?

Experiment creating the effect of fire using different mediums. This might be using pencil tones for shading, colouring pencils, crayons, pastels, paints or even computer software.
