Topic

LO: Henry VIII and the dissolution of monasteries



Starter Activities:

Who was Henry VIII? What facts do you know about him?

Share this information in the style of a fact (non-fiction) poster

What do we mean by dissolution of monasteries? Why did Henry VIII break away from the Church of Rome?

Task 1: To write a letter to Pope Clement VII, in role as either Henry VII or Katherine of Aragon, asking him to annul or uphold the marriage of Katherine and Henry.

Task 2: Compare and contrast how Elizabeth and her father Henry VIII created/dealt with religious divisions in England.

Extension Task: What do you think might have happened if Pope Clement had said 'yes' to Henry's request? Explain your thoughts/answer.
