Topic

We are starting our new topic of Stone
Age to Iron Age. Use the introduction to
the Stone Age to find out more
information about the first part of our
topic.

Read through the knowledge organizer and then complete the KWL grid.

History

LO: To understand how huntergatherers survived in the Stone Age.

Work through the PowerPoint to find out information about hunter-gatherers in the Stone Age. Ask an adult to hide the plant pictures around your house and see if you can gather all of the plants.

Choose the plenary questions that match your understanding to complete.

Art

LO: To create a cave art painting using natural materials.

In this session we are recreating a Stone Age cave painting. Think about what kinds of natural materials would have been used to make these paintings. Then, using crushed fruit or plants/mud, create your own cave art painting of an animal or your hand.

Use the examples to help you.

Topic

LO: To create a fact file about the extinct Woolly Mammoth

Use the PowerPoint and information sheet to find out more information about the Woolly Mammoth. Create a fact file about the extinct animal and complete the labelling activity.

BONUS: Can you find out any additional facts about the Woolly Mammoth.

Computing

LO: To create a PowerPoint about Stonehenge.

In this lesson, we are finding out about the Neolithic Stonehenge. Use the resources provided, or use your own to research about Stonehenge. Then, use Microsoft PowerPoint to show all that you have learnt. You may want to include some pictures alongside your writing.

Growth Mindset

LO: To debate whether we are born to be good at something.

Work through the PowerPoint. Look at the image. Who is this and why is he famous?

Using the sheet, debate whether he was born to be good at what he does.
