<u>RE Lesson 1</u> LO: To answer the enquiry question 'What is the importance of Islamic stories?' Think carefully about the 3 stories that we looked at and what Muslims can learn from them. Then, in your own words, write a few lines to explain why you think Islamic stories are important. Use the examples given if you are not sure how to start.	<u>RE Lesson 2</u> LO: To discuss our prior knowledge of Sikhism and key ideas. We are looking at a new enquiry question - What makes Sikhs special? Use the PowerPoint to cover some of the key information about Sikhism. Then, complete the KWL grid filling in the K for what we have learnt and the 'K' for any questions that you would like to find out about.	<u>Science</u> Our new unit is focused on Forces and Magnets. Can you fill in your KWL grid for this unit? Spend some time researching our new unit.
<u>French</u> LO: To follow a familiar story in French. Read through the story of 'The Greedy Dog' based on the story of the very hungry caterpillar. Can you recognise any of the numbers that we have learnt. Use the English translated sheet to help you figure out the names of the food that we are looking at in this story. Choose the differentiated sheet that matches your understanding of this lesson to complete.	<u>PSHE</u> Growth Mindset Our focus in this session is challenge and how we can overcome barriers to learning. <u>Task one:</u> have a look at the key vocabulary. Can you sort them into groups? Why have you grouped the words together? <u>Task two:</u> You need to create your own challenge mountain. Think about an aspect of learning you have found difficult. What have you found challenging? What barriers are there? How could you overcome the barriers? Illustrate your challenge in the form of a mountain.	<u>Topic</u> LO: To make maps of surviving UK monuments from the Stone, Bronze and Iron age. In this session we will be looking at a map of the UK and identifying surviving monuments. Use the PowerPoint to learn about the different settlements that were used and why certain land was more or less appropriate for different settlements. Then choose the differentiated sheet to complete to consolidate your learning.
