



Reception Home Learning Week Commencing 8th November 2021



Session 1 Exciting Writing	Session 2 LO: to recite and write the alphabet.	Session 3 LO: to write a simple title.	Session 4 LO: to sequence words to form a sentence.
Input: Discuss and explore bonfire night. What did you see? What did you hear? What could you smell? What did you taste? If you didn't see any fireworks find a video to watch on Youtube. Task: Draw a firework picture. Then add some words to describe what you could see/hear/smell/taste. Eg bang, pop, crackle, candyfloss, marshmallows, hot chocolate, whizz etc. Remember to use your phonics knowledge to help you.	Input: Sing the alphabet. Don't sing it too quickly. Listen carefully to all the letters. Use the resources sheets to help you match the sound/name to the letters. Task: Complete the alphabet handwriting worksheets. Challenge: Can you find something in your home that begins with each letter of the alphabet?	Input: We've been learning about non-fiction texts along with year 1. Today we are thinking about a title for a book about the Great Fire of London. Can you think of a good title for your book about the Great Fire? Ask a grownup to help your jot down your ideas. Task: using the booklet template, choose your best title and make a simple book about the Great Fire of London. <i>Parents, this can be very child led. Let them draw and mark make as they wish. Support them with writing if they ask for it.</i>	Input: Read your reading book together. Talk about that sounds make up words and words make up sentences. Task: Look at the words on the resource sheet. Read the sentences together. Then cut up each sentence at a time, muddle the words and ask your child if they can put the words in the correct order. Repeat the sentence orally if needed. Read it back to check it makes sense. Stick them down.
