





#### Session 1

## LO: to explore key features of traditional tales.

Input: Work through the Powerpoint, discussing traditional tales. Do you know any traditional tales? Who are the characters? Are there any similar features across several traditional tales?

Spend time reading, watching and listening to different traditional tales. Find any traditional tales you have at home to share or watch video versions on Youtube. Which are your favourites?

## Session 2

#### LO: to segment the sounds in a word.

Recap the phonics sounds you know so far using your phonics pack.

Look at the images in the resources. Can you hear all the sounds in the words? Use your phonics flashcards to build some of the words.

## Session 3

# LO: to describe Little Red Riding Hood's appearance.

Look at the image of Little Red Riding Hood.
How can you describe her? Think carefully about what she looks like but also what her personality is like after rereading the story of Little Red Riding Hood.

## Session 4

#### LO: to make inferences from an image.

Look carefully at the Cinderella image. Discuss the image. What can you see? Who is in the picture? What is happening? What might happen next? Share your ideas with an adult. Record some ideas and share on Tapestry.

#### Session 5

Practise your handwriting! Can you form all the phonics sounds you have learnt so far correctly? Practise on a piece of paper.

Remember, none of your letters start at the bottom!
