Remember: -sit your letters on the line correctly. -correct letter formation. -Take your time. <i>Please continue to practise your handwriting when you have time.</i>	Activity: Main Activity: write one sentence using 'and'. Then draw a picture to accompany your sentence. Something harder: complete the 'and' activity sheet. You may need some additional lined paper or space in an exercise book.	Activity: Practise writing your tricky words. Can you write them in lots of different colours? Challenge: can you use the tricky words to make sentences? Write your sentences in your best writing.	Activity: Main activity: watch the video of Miss Bleakley reading <i>Traction Man</i> . Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story. Can you write a sentence to explain why it is your favourite part? Something harder: Can you answer some questions about the <i>Traction Man</i> story.	Activity: Can you write a character description? Remember to include the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Neat writing with letters sitting on the line correctly. - Letters formed correctly. - Capital letters and full stops in the right places. - Can you use 'and' to extend some of your sentences? - Use some adjectives to help describe what the characters looks, smells, moves, feels and sounds like.
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
