Reception Maths Activity Grid- wc 26th April 2021

LO: to share objects into equal groups.

Resources: a selection of objects eg lego bricks, counters, pasta pieces.

Ask: What are equal groups? How can we make equal groups? What does equal mean?

Model how to share a group of objects equally-eg 8 objects between 2 or 4 people.

Practise this a few times together and then ask the children to share a group of objects equally between some teddies.

How do they know they have shared them equally?

LO: to identify odd and even numbers.

Resources: cubes/lego bricks.

Build a tower of bricks for each number 1-10. Ask the children to explore different amounts of objects and investigate if they are odd or even numbers. Even numbers can be shared equally into 2 groups but odd numbers cannot.

Ask: Which numbers can be shared equally? Which numbers are odd/even? How do you know?

LO: to share objects into equal groups.



Teddy bear picnic

Provide 2 teddy bears, 2 plates and small even quantities of loose parts to represent different food items.

Ask the children to share out the loose parts fairly so that each teddy gets the same. What will happen if another teddy joins the picnic?

LO: to identify odd and even numbers.

Modelling area



Take children for a walk to look at the house numbers on a nearby street. What do they notice? Encourage them to make their own model houses and line them up in order on the odd and even sides of the street.
