Activity: On your thought bubble write a sentence as if you was one of the cats in the poems. But instead of a full stop use an exclamation mark.	Activity: Today we are creating our own 'I had a Little Horse' but changing the animal and words. Have a go practising out loud what you would like to write before re-writing your new poem.	Activity: After reading the sentences independently add the information to the picture.
