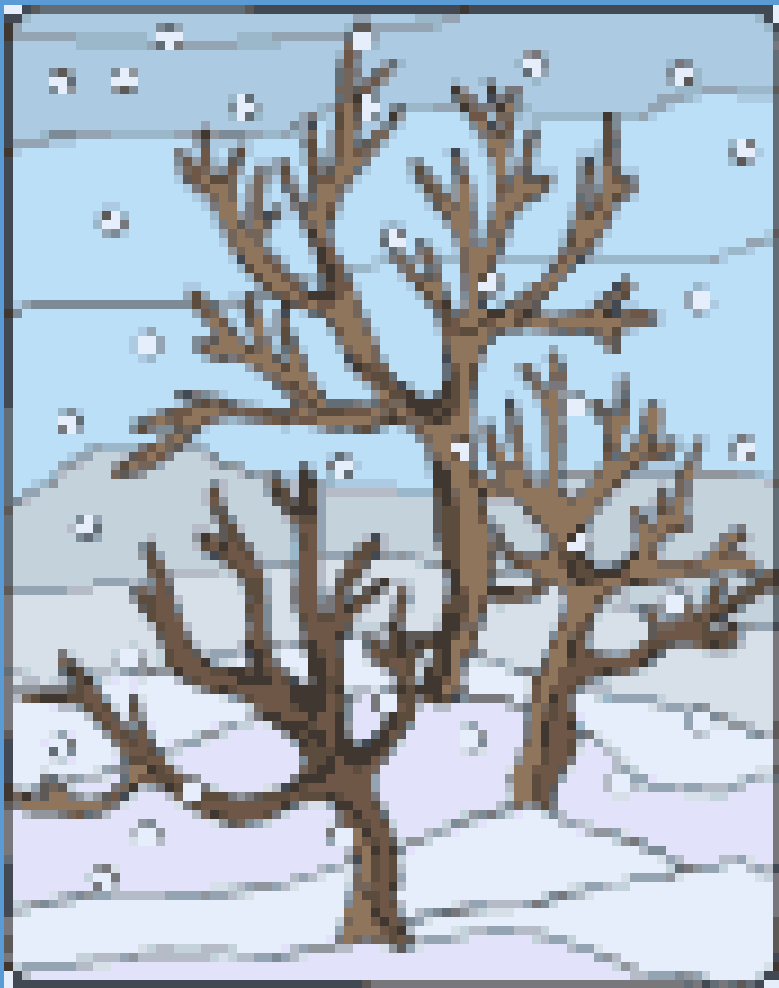
Facts vs Opinions

- For example, 'Fire is hot.'

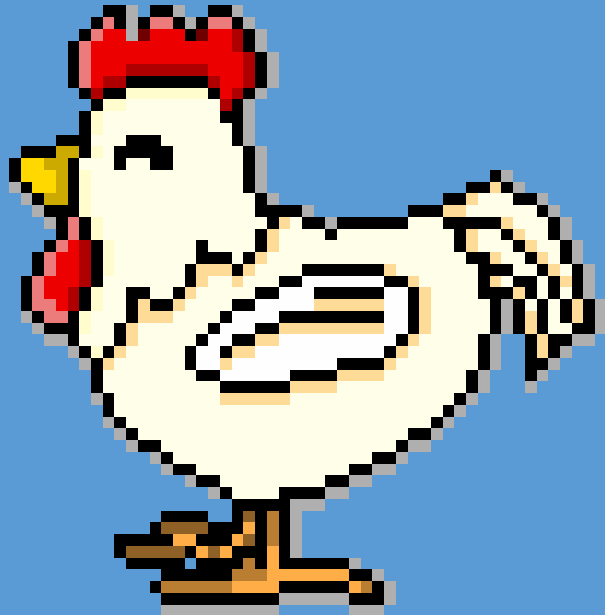
Opinions:

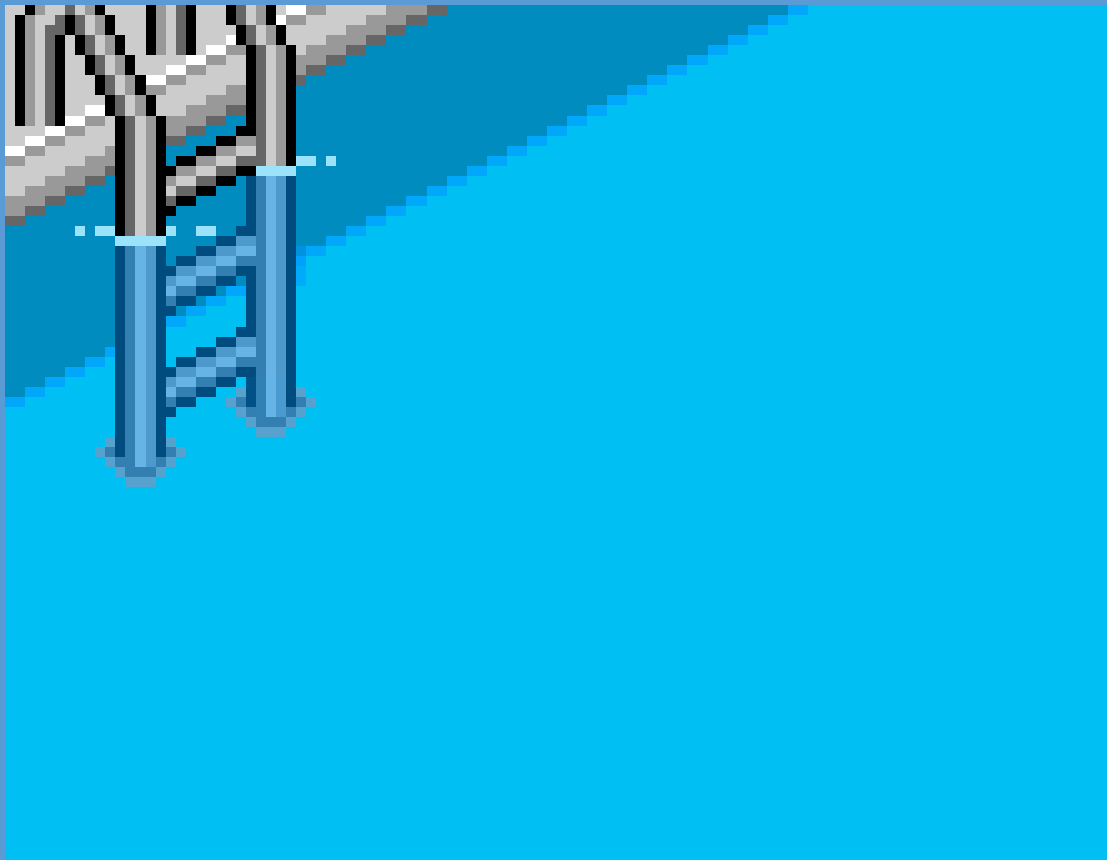
Chickens lay eggs.

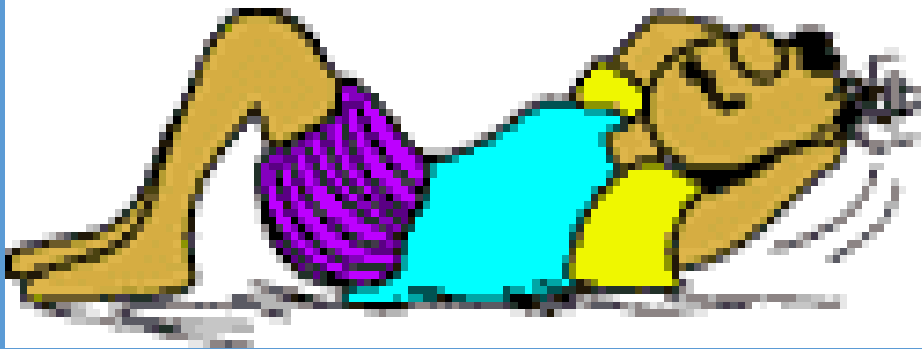

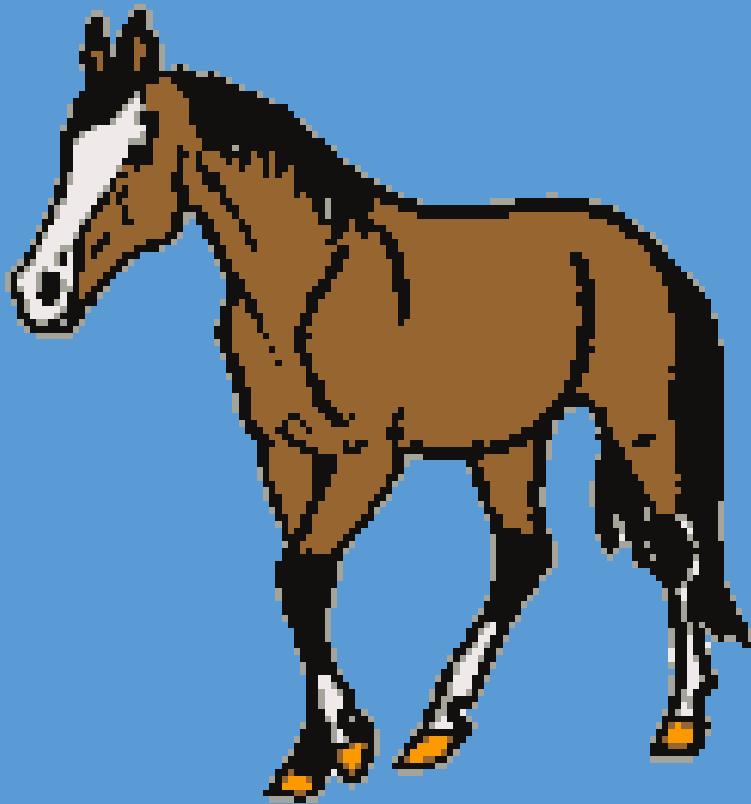

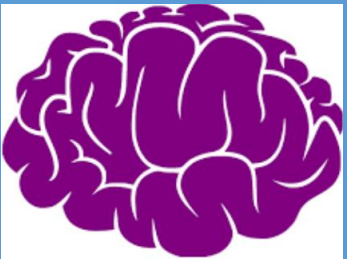
