Warm up- nouns and verbs!



Noun



Verb

Suffix

-ed



I **play** football.



Yesterday I **played** football.



I **laugh** at jokes.



Yesterday I **laughed** at some jokes.



I **ask** for help.



Yesterday I **asked** for help.



Ben can jump.



Yesterday Ben jumped.

Regular verbs (add -ed in past tense)

play → played

laugh → laughed

need → needed

look → looked

ask → asked

call → called



Sometimes I **run** around
playing tag.



This morning I **ran**
around playing tag.

I **throw** the ball to my friend and she **catches** it.



I **threw** the ball to my friend and she **caught** it.



I **say** my name is Bill.



I **said** my name is Bill.

Irregular verbs (They break the rules! You just have to learn them!)

go  went

say  said

make  made

take  took

think  thought

is  was

Now try these:

It is sunny



It **was** sunny

We have Assembly today



We **had** Assembly today

We go swimming



We **went** swimming

I think P.E. is fun



I **thought** P.E. **was** fun

My dad helps me with my homework



My dad **helped** me with my homework

We need to tidy up the cloakroom



We **needed** to tidy up the cloakroom
