Text Structure

- An opening statement eg Vegetables are good for you.
- Arguments made, point by point. Each point explained eg They contain vitamins.
 Vitamin C is needed for...
- Summary and return to the opening argument eg We have seen that... so...

Sentence/Word Level Features

- Simple present tense.
- Use general terms eg women, vegetables...
- Logical connectives eg this shows, however, because...
- Use strong positive words.
- Use short sentences to make your point.



Persuasion



You are trying to make someone change their mind and agree with you.

Making the Text Interesting

- Use good reasons and evidence to convince the reader.
- Use facts.
- Try to get the reader interested and on your side.
- Make the reader think that everyone does this eg We all know that...
- Be informative, persuasive and friendly.
- Use humour to get people on your side.
- Alliteration can make slogans memorable eg Buy British Beef!
