<p>Session 1</p> <p>LO: To use adjectives to describe a character in a sentence.</p> <p>Input: work through the Powerpoint and discuss what an adjective is. Discuss how you can level up an adjective to improve your choice.</p> <p>Task: Choose a character from the story of Little Red Riding Hood. Write some sentences to describe them. Use the level up word mat to ensure you select good adjectives!</p>	<p>Session 2</p> <p>LO: To compare differences and similarities between the two Grandmas in Little Red Riding Hood.</p> <p>Input: work through the powerpoint and discuss the similarities and differences between the two characters.</p> <p>Task: stick the 2 grandma characters onto a piece of paper. Sort the words to describe each of them.</p>	<p>Session 3</p> <p>LO: To write an interview question and answer for a character in 'Little Red Riding Hood'.</p> <p>Input: work through the Powerpoint and discuss questions you might ask to some of the characters in the story of Little Red Riding Hood.</p> <p>Watch an interview with the Big Bad Wolf: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=U8ihdf4DN3Y</p> <p>Task: Write and record some questions and answers to one of the characters. eg record a question you would ask the wolf and then consider that his answer might be.</p>
<p>Session 4</p> <p>LO: To perform an interview role playing as a character.</p> <p>Input: work through the Powerpoint. Recap the learning from the previous lesson. What questions are you asking and what might the character you have chosen say?</p> <p>Task: choose your best questions and answers to perform like a real interview!</p>	<p>Session 5</p> <p>Practise your word wall!</p> <p>Choose 5 words you don't know to make into a game. Hide them around the house, make a snap or pairs games.</p> <p>Challenge: write a sentence using each of your words from the word wall!</p>
