Session 1

LO: To use a conjunction to join two parts of a sentence.

Input: Work through the Powerpoint and discuss some of the following key questions. What does a sentence need? What is a conjunction? Explain that we can make our sentences more interesting by using conjunctions.

Task: Select the activity sheet you feel most confident with. Complete the activities.

Session 4

Practise your word wall!

Choose 5 words you don't know to make into a game. Hide them around the house, make a snap or pairs games.

Challenge: write a sentence using each of your words from the word wall!

Session 2

LO: LO: to write a character description

Input: Work through the Powerpoint. Recap learning from last week- what is an adjective? How can we describe the wolf from LRRH? Write a short character description together using the senses to help prompt ideas. Discuss what makes a good character description.

Task: Write a character description using your chosen template. Can you describe the wolf on the wanted poster?

Session 5

Exciting Writing- Halloween!

Discuss the story opening on the writing template. If you turn around what would you see? Consider something scary, linking to the theme of Halloween. Can you continue the story?

Session 3

LO: LO: to edit and improve my writing.

Input: Discuss the following questions. What does it mean to edit? How could you improve your character description from the previous session? What are capital letters? Full stops? How can you improve your word choices?

Task: edit your work. Using the editing station prompts, take time to edit each aspect of your character description in a different coloured pen.
