Teaching input: We are going to look at some books by Julia Donaldson. Watch the video of Miss Kelly reading 'Snail and the Whale', and reveal your task.	Teaching input: Today we are looking at conjunctions and how we can use different ones to connect our sentences. Watch the lesson video.	Teaching input: We are going to look at how Julia Donaldson use repetition and use it in our own writing. Watch Miss Kelly model how to do this.	Teaching input: Today we are going to compare 'Zog' and 'Snail and the Whale' before watching today's lesson re-listen to the stories to refresh your brain.	Teaching input: Watch the teacher video to find out about today's task.
Activity: Something easier: Role play as one of the characters from the story. What would they say at the beginning, middle and end of the story? Film a video for Tapestry. Main task: Role play as one of the characters from the Snail and the Whale. What would they say to one of the other characters? Draw and label your characters and write what they would say in the speech bubbles. Something harder: Consider what the other character would say back to your character. Role play with someone else at home and record your ideas on lined paper.	Activity: Something easier: Cut out the sentences and using 'and' connect them to make long sentences. Main Task: Choose which conjunction you think works best to join the two sentences. Extension Challenge: Can you extend the sentence by adding a conjunction and your own sentence.	Activity: Something easier: Circle the repetitive phrases and fill in the blank spaces, this can be spoken to a grown up. Main Task: Circle the repetitive phrases, using your favourite phrase write a little section of the story. Watch Miss Kelly's model to help. Extension Challenge: Can you perform your writing with expression?	Activity: Fill in the grid to compare the two stories. Use the grid your child feels most comfortable with. Remember you can always re-listen to Miss Kelly reading the stories to help you.	Activity: Today's exciting writing is writing instructions. Can you write instructions to make jam on toast.
