



The conjunction 'but' is used in a sentence to join or link words, phrases or clauses together.




James needed to wear sun cream but he had forgotten to pack it.






The conjunction 'or' is used in a sentence to join or link words and phrases together.








The conjunction 'because' can be used in the middle or at the beginning of a sentence to join two phrases.



We played a board game **because** it was a rainy day.




Monika doesn't drink milk **because** she is allergic to it.
