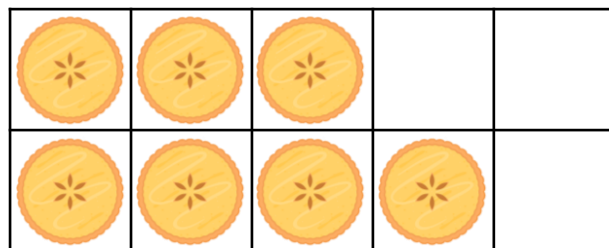
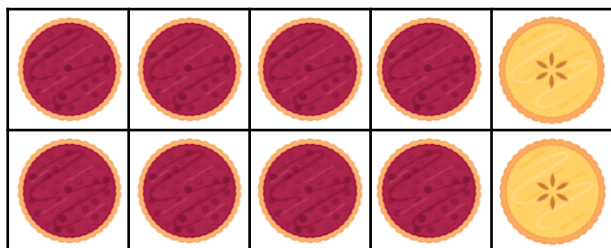


Add by Making 10
