Remember to write the answer on the line.

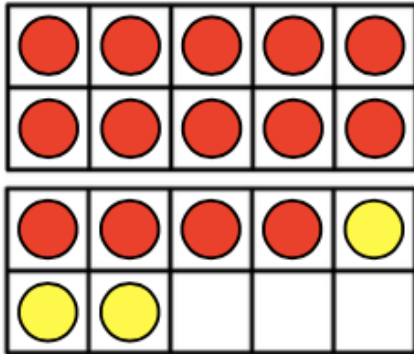
Keywords

More than = bigger

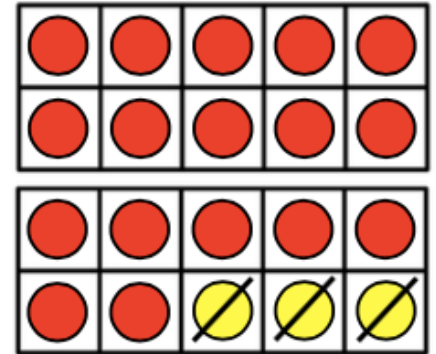
Less than = smaller

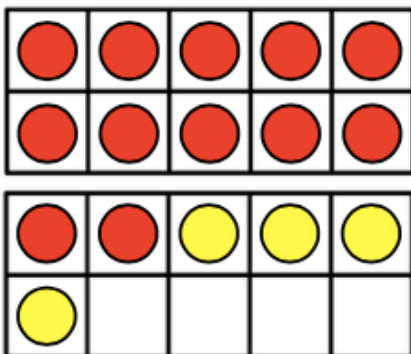


$$14 + 3 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

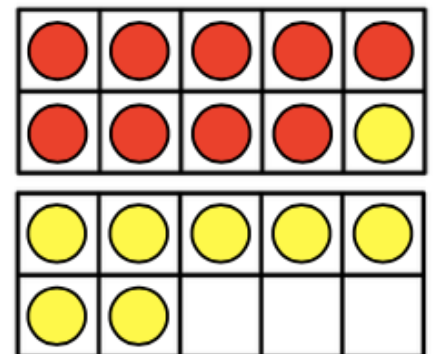

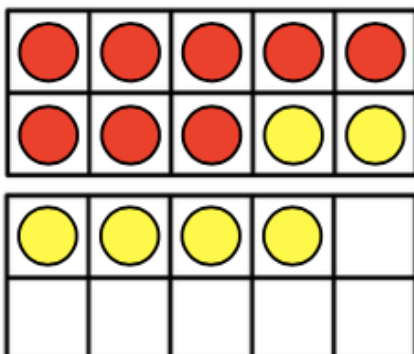

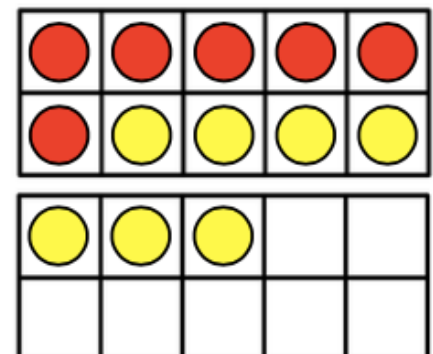
