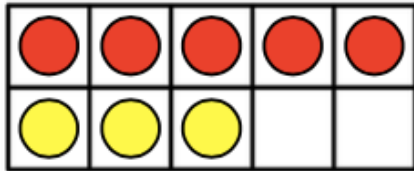
Keywords

More than = bigger

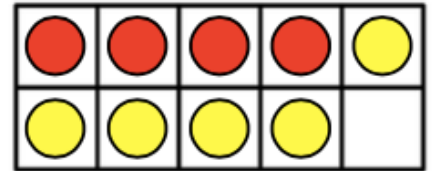
Less than = smaller

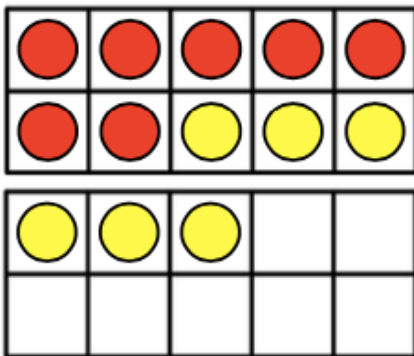

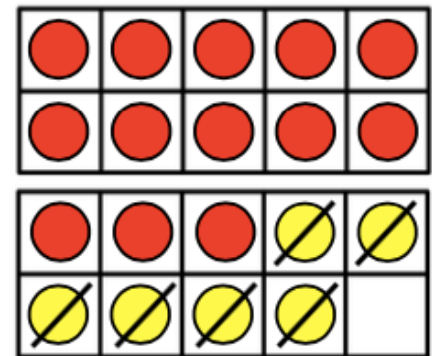

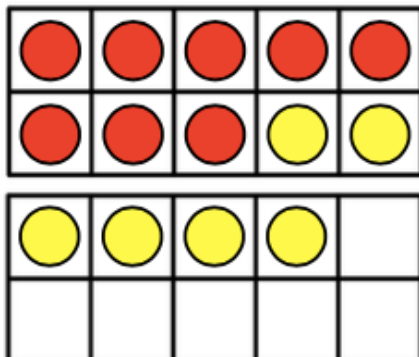

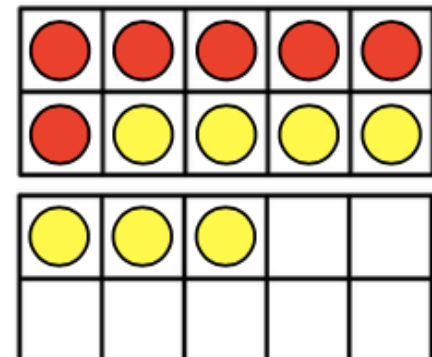

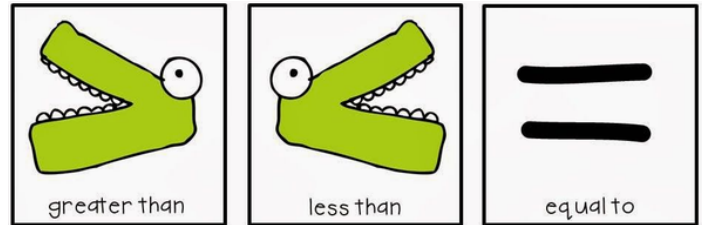
