Input: Follow the presentation. Today we are looking at adjectives to describe a setting. What is an adjective- a describing word. What is a setting- a place in a story.	Input: Follow the presentation. We are looking at the verbs today. Remember verbs are action words! See if you can act out each verb from the verb mat.	Input: Follow the presentation. Today we are going to write our own story of 'Traction Man is at our school'. Imagine that one of the baddies is a stapler. What would his name be? Evil stapler has stolen Scrubbing Brush, How will Traction Man save him?	Input: Last week we zoomed a nurse who answered a lot of our interesting questions. Can you write a letter to say thank you?
Activity: Create a list of adjectives you want to use for the Traction Man setting. Try and include as many adjectives that will blow the socks off your teacher!	Activity: Using the 4 different pictures of Traction man, write a sentence for each picture using verbs. Challenge: Can you use an adverb to describe your verb.	Activity: Using the story map draw pictures of what will happen in your story and then write notes about what will happen. Challenge: Using your story map can you tell your story to someone else?	Activity: Write a letter to say thank you to Laura for zooming with us. Use the keywords to help you write sentences and look at what Miss Kelly wrote in her letter. (You can even steal her ideas!)
