Activity/Resources: Work through the PowerPoint on adverts. With a grown up or sibling, look at the example advert and see if you can identify any of the key features. Think about what you like about the advert, what you think the purpose of the advert is, and if you would you buy what the advert is selling. Pick two of the advertisement posters and see if you can identify the key features. Which advert do you prefer and why?	Activity/Resources: Listen to the second part of Chapter 3 (The Iron Man - Chapter 3 by Ted Hughes - YouTube) - from 3:58. Using the key features of an advert from last lesson, can you plan the layout of your poster and think about the key pieces of information that you are going to use. We are trying to create an advert for people to rent The Iron Man, perhaps to do jobs for them.	Activity/Resources: Using your plan from last lesson, create a final version of your advertisement poster. Remember to check back at the key features to make sure you have included everything. Challenge: Can you include a hyperbolic phrase? (This is an exaggerated phrase e.g. This is the best chocolate in the whole universe.)	Activity/Resources: Last week, we wrote a non-fiction double page spread about our RE topic of Islam. Using the editing stations, can you read and improve your exciting writing. You should focus on punctuation, spelling, handwriting, word quality and sentence structure. You should also double check your non-fiction information to make sure that it is accurate. Note: If you need your teacher to send a copy of your work home, let them know.
